

Directions with landmarks to Camp Maumee

From Bloomington, Indiana

1. IN-46 East to IN-446 South (on the east side of Bloomington). Henderson Creek Road will be 16 miles from IN-46. You will travel across the Lake Monroe dam.
2. At around 11 miles, you will see Tower Ridge Road (10 miles of gravel & potholes). You do NOT want this road. Ignore the Camp Maumee sign.
3. Many of the cross roads will have signs giving you advance notice. Unfortunately, Henderson Creek Road does not have one of these signs. However, on the right side of IN-446 will be a large white sign for Meadows Community Church. On your left will be Henderson Creek Road, and there is a small green street sign. This is the last street sign you will see. Henderson Creek Road is paved with 4 miles of gravel. — Turn left (east) from 446 onto Henderson Creek Road for 2.6 miles.
4. Turn left (north) onto Hickory Grove Road. Just before Hickory Grove Road there is a large red barn. Just after this road there is a smaller red house/shed. Turn between the two onto Hickory Grove Road (remember, no street signs).
5. Continue on Hickory Grove Rd 3.4 miles (2.4 miles paved, followed by 1 mile of gravel). At one point you will come to a Y in the road. Go right.
6. After passing Hickory Grove Church (on your right – there is also a cemetery), turn left (north) onto Jackson Rd/CR-890N/CR-1440W.
7. Continue for 1.6 miles and then turn right onto CR-925N. There is a small green Camp Maumee sign on the right side of the intersection.
8. Continue on CR-925N for 1.4 miles and the camp entrance will be on the right (sign).
